- Is the staff trained in First Aid and CPR?

- What type of enrichment do you provide infants?
- Where do infants spend the majority of their time?
- Can you describe a typical day for an infant in your program?
- Are infants grouped by age or developmental level?
- Do infants receive supervised rest/nap time?
- How is discipline handled?
- How much time is spent reading to the infants?
- Can parents participate in program planning?
- Does music play a role in the curriculum?
- Will I receive daily reports about my child?
