Sharon Groh-Wargo, PhD, RDN is Professor, Nutrition and Pediatrics, at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine in Cleveland, Ohio. Dr. Groh-Wargo has over 40 years of experience as a neonatal dietitian, is a nationally known speaker and researcher, and has authored numerous publications on neonatal nutrition. She is a contributor

to all three editions of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics' *Pocket Guide to Neonatal Nutrition* and authored a chapter on "Lactoengineering" for the 3rd edition of "*Infant and Pediatric Feedings: Guidelines for Preparation of Human Milk and Formula in Health Care Facilities*". She participates in the *BEGIN Project – Breastmilk Ecology: Genesis of Infant Nutrition* - sponsored by the NIH in cooperation with the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics, which was convened to investigate human milk as a unique biological system. Dr. Groh-Wargo received the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics' Medallion Award in recognition of her professional contributions.

Terrie is a neonatal clinical nurse specialist with many years of professional practice devoted to supporting newborns at risk.
