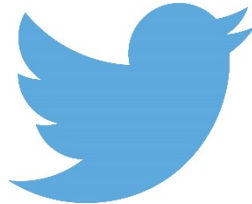


NEONATAL OPIOID WITHDRAWAL SYNDROME
